

Dr Roman Sosnowski has been working for more than two decades at The Uro-oncology Department at the Cancer Memorial Hospital, Maria Curie-Skłodowska in Warsaw, Poland. He completed his specialization in urology at the Urological Department of the Medical Center of Postgraduate Education in Warsaw, Poland (a department of urology with the accreditation of the European Board of Urology). In 2005 he was awarded the title of a urologist as well as the title of Fellow of the European Board of Urology (FEBU) awarded by the European Association of Urology. His main areas of interest include; surgical treatments related to the bladder, the kidneys and prostate cancer but also testicular and penile cancer. He participated in some clinical fellowships at some of the leading Urological institutions in Denmark, Germany, Canada or USA. Recently he has been deeply involved with a multi-centre and collaboration across Europe, mainly due to The European Association of Urology network.

For the past few years, he has been interested in health awareness and prophylactics. He has been collaborating with different patients, organizations and institutions for more than ten years, which support education - organized content for their seminars, magazines and websites as well giving them lectures on various topics related to urology. In 2000 he applied and successfully obtained a three-year educational grant from the European Union for the purpose of "Development and implementation of urological cancer prevention programs connected to employed men over the age of 45, and orientated towards the counteraction of unemployment", which successfully finished at the end of December 2013.
