The IKCC Board, our Medical Advisory Board, and our conference organising committee, has decided to postpone and move our Global Kidney Cancer Summit for 2020.

In light of the impact of COVID-19 (coronavirus) and the interests of our delegates, speakers and sponsors, we have taken the unprecedented decision to move this year's Global Kidney Cancer Summit from Singapore to Europe.

This decision has been taken after careful consideration of the available evidence to ensure the health, well-being and safety of all our conference attendees.

To this end, we have decided to hold our conference in Europe in the fall of 2020. The date is yet to be confirmed. As soon as we have scoped details of the conference and confirmed the venue and date, we will let you know.

The IKCC remains committed to growing the kidney cancer patient voice in Asia and supports the development and sustainability of organisations in the region. It is our intent to host the Global Kidney Cancer Summit in Singapore in April 2021.
