Professor Shankar Siva is a Radiation Oncologist and leads the stereotactic body radiotherapy (SABR) service at the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre and is an internationally recognized leader in the field. He has been a pioneer in SABR for primary kidney cancer and led the practice changing TROG 15.03 FASTRACK II trial, as well as first-in-human trials of SABR and immunotherapy combinations for oligometastatic RCC and prior to nephrectomy. He is the founder and chair of the International Radiosurgery Oncology Consortium for Cancers of the Kidney (iROCK). He has over 350 peer reviewed publications, and \$30 million in competitive grant funding. His current research focused on high-tech radiotherapy delivery, advanced functional imaging in kidney cancer, and has a passion for improving outcomes in patients afflicted with kidney cancer. He is the current Cancer Council Victoria Colebatch Fellow.
